

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to invite you to an adapted Open Evening for Scalby School on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> September. You will be aware that we have had to make alterations to our school building due to the presence of RAAC concrete on our school site. Unfortunately, this means at this time we are unable to invite you onto our Scalby School site whilst mitigation work is completed.

We have however, secured the function room at Scarborough Rugby Club, Silver Royd, Scalby Road, YO13 ONL. During this evening, you will receive a talk from the headteacher, Mr Robertson and members of the Senior Leadership Team.

I am sure there are many questions surrounding the current circumstances with the accessibility of our school site, all of these will be answered on this evening. Work is currently being completed around the clock to ensure that we can get all students on our site as soon as possible. By the start of the 23/24 academic school year, the relevant mitigation and site work should have been completed so that your child will have the full Scalby experience.

We will be operating an online booking system for this event. We will be running three identical sessions, these will be at 5:30-6:00pm, 6:30-7pm and 7:30pm-8pm. Each of these sessions can accommodate 230 people. In order to allow space for everyone to attend, we ask that each family bring a maximum of two people. This can be a child and adult, or two adults. We do have access to the bar area should any other family members wish to accompany the family party and wait whilst the talk is underway. Due to the restriction on numbers, for this year only, we ask that only Y6 students attend this evening. We will be able to welcome current Y5 students next year back onto our school site for an Open Evening.
