Others will be accommodated providing we have staff and space within our schools.

What has changed?



1 JUNE

We are still working out if it will be possible to welcome back students who have not been at school for some time. If it is possible, those students will be from Year 10 to help them prepare for their GCSEs. Priority will be given as described above.

What about their brothers and sisters?



Sorry, at this stage, only children in the year groups described above.



For now, students in other years need to stay at home.

Does my child have to come to school?



If your child is well and is asked to attend, then they should.



There will be no fines if you decide you do not want your child to go to school.

Why should more children attend school?



It is good for children's mental wellbeing.



School is the best place for them to learn.



It is good for children to socialise with other children.

How are you making sure school is safe?



We will check for risks before school opens.



If a child or family member is sick, they cannot come to school.



There will be fewer children in a classroom.



Everyone will wash their hands regularly.



School will be cleaned regularly.

What might change at school?



Parents and carers should not attend school with their child.



They will not have their normal lessons.



Your child may have a different classroom and a different teacher.



We will change how we serve lunch.

Will my child be tested?



If your child shows symptoms of Covid-19, yes, they will be able to be tested.

Will school be every day?



We will create five Year 10 groups, each attending school one day per week

What if there is a case of Covid-19 at school?



14 days

If anyone at school tests positive, the whole class must self-isolate for 14 days.



14 days

The people they live with must self-isolate for 14 days.



7 days

If you think you have symptoms, self-isolate for 7 days.
