Ebor Academy Filey Uniform, Appearance and Equipment Reminder

We are taking the opportunity, as this term draws to a close, to remind our students of some of the rules regarding uniform, appearance and equipment. We appreciate that many of our students are following, and will continue to follow, these rules but a small number are not. A fuller list of uniform and equipment rules is in the student planner but the key ones we would like to draw to students' attention are as follows:

Trousers & Skirts

Trousers must not be too tight, leggings style, or too close-fitting and skirts must be navy and at least knee length. Skirts should not be worn rolled up at the waistband.

Jewellery

Students may wear one plain pair of studded earrings and a wrist watch. You should not bring other jewellery or valuable property of any sort into school. All other jewellery will be confiscated and can be collected from reception after school. After school detentions will be issued to students who persistently wear excess jewellery in school.

Mobile phones

Mobile phones should be 'off and away' in lockers at all times; any phone seen or heard will be confiscated. This includes phones on display in shirt, trouser or blazer pockets. Phones that are confiscated will be returned to students at the end of the day in the first instance. Should there be a second occurrence, a call will be made home with the requirement for a parent/carer to collect the phone on their child's behalf. After school detentions will be issued to students who persistently use their mobile phone on site. The restriction is in place at all times while students are within school grounds; this includes the playgrounds, outside areas and when students arrive and leave the site at the end of the day. Phones should be away before students enter the school grounds and not accessed until they have left site.

Students are able to use the school phone at main reception should they need to contact parents with any concerns or to discuss collection following school-based activities.

Basic School Equipment

All students should bring their equipment with them every day. As a minimum, students are expected to bring the following items of equipment:


Pair of compasses	Pencil sharpener

Bringing the correct equipment every day is essential if lessons are to run smoothly and encourages good levels of organisation for our students. If they continue to fail to follow these rules then further action will be taken.
